OBJECTIVE 1: MONITOR THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE INTOSAI STRATEGIC PLAN, INCLUDING INTOSA'S PERFORMANCE MANAGEMENT

The PFAC monitors the implementation of the four goals and five cross-cutting priorities of the INTOSAI's Strategic Plan. Track progress on annual Goal Operational Plans, INTOSAI Strategic Plan and advise/support Goal Chairs in addressing issues identified. Track key actions and issues for consideration and decision by Governing Board to improve INTOSAI's governance and performance on topics such as financial matters or amendments of the Statutes. The PFAC leadership is now presenting the 2022 INTOSAI Performance and Accountability Report for approval by the PFAC prior to submission to the Governing Board for approval at INCOSAI XXIV.

OBJECTIVE 2: MANAGE AND OVERSEE INTOSAI'S RESOURCES

The PFAC is responsible for managing and overseeing INTOSAI's resources to carry out the Strategic Plan. The PFAC leadership plan to facilitate the use of surplus grants in response to INTOSAI/SAI needs and organizational priorities, developing INTOSAI triennial budget and clean audit opinion for yearly Financial Statements from external auditors. The PFAC and Governing Board might consider devoting some portion of these funds to enhance the translation of professional pronouncements.

OBJECTIVE 3: SUSTAIN AND FURTHER DEVELOP THE EFFORTS OF THE INTOSAI-DONOR COOPERATION

The PFAC is responsible for sustaining and further developing the efforts of the INTOSAI Donor Cooperation. The Cooperation facilitates the flow of funds from donors to SAIs that seek to enhance their capacity.

- INTOSAI Continuity Of Operations Fund During Pandemic

Under the leadership of Dr. Hussam Alangari, president of the General Court of Audit of Saudi Arabia, and Mr. Gene Dodaro, Comptroller General of the United States, the INTOSAI Covid-19 Continuity of Operations Grant Program provided funding for the purchase of information and communications technologies (ICT), as well as personal protective equipment, to respond to needs caused by the pandemic.

- The Saudi Fund for Improved SAI Performance

The PFAC established the Saudi Fund for SAI Improved Performance (Saudi FSIP) with about \$2 million in funds for grants to assist SAIs in the ASOSAI region with information technology and related training. SAI Saudi Arabia has provided an additional opportunity to support SAIs in all INTOSAI regions with an additional fund of \$1 million that will be awarded based on proposals submitted via IDI.

OBJECTIVE 4: ENSURE THE EFFICIENCY, EFFECTIVENESS, AND ECONOMY OF INTOSAI

Over the last year, we have worked closely with the General Secretariat to ensure that INTOSAI's work and administration continued without disruption. The PFAC Vice Chair has led the development of the 2023-2028 INTOSAI Strategic Plan within the PFAC. Developing a shorter, concise strategic plan and creating separate operational plans for each goal. Updating the organizational priorities (formerly operational priorities) to guide the focus of INTOSAI's work.



OBJECTIVE 5: SUPPORT INTOSAI IN RESPONDING TO THE SAI COMMUNITY NEEDS

The PFAC maintains close cooperation with INTOSAI bodies to report issues for discussion with PFAC members' and coordinate INTOSAI-wide response. Support INTOSAI members efforts to adapt to changing circumstances, such as a pandemic and raise awareness of SAI's contribution to the implementation of the SDGs and the Agenda 2030 internally and externally.

OBJECTIVE 6: PROMOTE EQUALITY AND INCLUSIVENESS IN INTOSAI OPERATIONS

Enhance member participation in INTOSAI initiatives. Support related policies and practices within INTOSAI. Encourage INTOSAI bodies to carry out their operations and activities in a sustainable manner.
